

Central Highlands Regional Growth Plan - Have your say

The Central Highlands Regional Growth Plan is currently being prepared in a partnership between local government, state agencies and authorities.

The plan will help provide broad direction for land use and development across the region. In particular it will:

- identify important economic, social and cultural resources to be preserved, maintained or developed,
- provide direction for accommodating growth and change for residential, employment, industrial, commercial, agricultural and other rural activities,
- consider the infrastructure needed to support growth and change, and
- help streamline planning policy and provide solutions to common strategic planning issues for the region.

An initial phase of developing the Regional Growth Plan involves seeking feedback from the community about the long term future of the region. The Project Steering Committee invites you to provide comments about the proposed directions for the plan.

A strategic directions brochure has been prepared for your comment, setting out:

- principles to guide the Regional Growth Plan, and a
- draft concept plan for regional growth


